Bank of Fayetteville Donates Funds for Book Drops to Fayetteville Public Library

FAYETTEVILLE – The Bank of Fayetteville will donate \$15,000 to the Fayetteville Public Library to pay for three remote drop-off boxes.

The check presentation will be Monday, Dec. 11 at 10 am at the Fayetteville Public Library.

The three boxes will be set up at various Bank of Fayetteville locations: Wedington Drive, North College Avenue and Arkansas 265.

“We are so grateful for the Bank of Fayetteville’s continued support of the library,” Executive Director Louise Schaper said. “These remote drop-off boxes will enable us to better serve library patrons who may be unable to drive to the downtown location to return a book.”

The Fayetteville Public Library’s Board of Trustees recently approved the strategic plan that the library began working on last fall. The plan calls for improved access, including implementing remote returns in various locations.

“We are excited to be working with the Fayetteville Public Library on the book drop project. The Bank of Fayetteville and the Fayetteville Public library have a similar goal of serving our community. The book drops that will be placed at our branches around town are another example of this commitment to the community,” said Mary Beth Brooks, President of the Bank of Fayetteville.

The remote drop-offs are scheduled to be in place by the first quarter of 2007.
